

1st Giro - Replica 2009

San Vigilio - Furcia Pass (finishing line 1) - peak/ Plan de Coronas (finishing line 2)

Non competitive amateurish uphill time trial

Friday, July 10th 2009 from 9 to 12 a.m.

Participation conditions

General informations

Date: Friday, July 10th 2009

Assembly point and start: parking place Miara

Finishing line 1: peak - Plan de Coronas, difference in height 1080m, distance: 12,9km

Finishing line 2 . Furcia Pass

Starting time: 9 - 12 a.m.

Participation fee until July 7th: € 20 (fee includes 1 race jersey, 1 medal of merit, 1 pasta with drink, return journey Plan de Coronas / peak - Furcia Pass on cableway)

Participation fee from July 7th 1 to July 10th : € 25 (fee includes 1 race jersey, 1 medal of merit, 1 pasta with drink, return journey Plan de Coronas / peak - Furcia Pass on cableway)

Participants can pick up the chip for the electronic time keeping at the tourist office in San Vigilio (8.30 - 12.00 a.m. and 3.00 - 6.30 p.m.) as well as on the racing day (8.00 - 12.00 a.m.), after which they can start.

The racing time refers to the victory of the Giro d' Italia stage 2008 - Plan de Coronas of Franco Pellizotti and is of 40'26". The uphill time trial can be contended either on mountain bike or on a racing bicycle.

Finishing line 1 - peak - Plan de Coronas

- 1) Performance grade A: gold medal - racing time less than 60'26"
- 2) Performance grade B: silver medal - racing time less than 1h 20'26"
- 3) Performance grade C: bronze medal - racing time over 1h 20'26"

Finishing line 2 - Furcia Pass

- 4) Performance grade D: bronze medal with plate "Passo Furcia"

1. Route and carrying out:

The non competitive amateurish uphill time trial follows this course: parking place Miara – Furcia Pass (finishing line 2) – peak – Plan de Coronas (finishing line 1). Participants can enter the race between 9 and 12 a.m. The assistance of private vehicles following the race is strictly prohibited. Refreshments and the medical backup service are covered until the end of the race.

As participants cross the finishing line, they hand over the chip and immediately he will be given the medal of his performance grade. (as you see above), and a voucher for 1 pasta and drink and another one for the race jersey.

Then participants **must** get down to Furcia Pass on cableway. There, at the restaurant Furcia they can get the pasta and drink and at the tourist office you can get the race jersey showing the voucher.

Important: The road between Furcia Pass and San Vigilio will be closed to traffic (including cyclists) until 1 p.m.; the road peak/ Plan de Coronas –. Passo Furcia will be closed to traffic (including cyclists) until 3 p.m. Detour Valdaora – Perca – San Vigilio.

2. Entry:

Open to all adult female and male riders and minors over 15 (fifteen). Cyclists must submit a medical certificate not to be dated previous to January 1st 2009. The Organizing Committee may decide at any time whether to accept or not the enrolment or to exclude at any time an enrolled contestant for the event that may damage the image of the event.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel in time the event when the minimum number of participants is not to be reached.

In that case the registration fee will be refunded.

3. Enrolment procedure:

The entry is considered complete after the registration and the payment of the participation fee. The participation fee is 20 € until July 7th and 25 € from July 8th to the race day (a person).

Then entry can be made online until July 9th. Participants can also enter directly at the tourist office until the day of the race until 12 a.m.

4. Participation fee

The participation fee is 20 € until July 7th and 25 € from July 8th to the race day.

Payment of the entry fee includes 1 race jersey, 1 medal of merit, 1 pasta with drink, 1 return ticket cableway peak- Plan de Corones - Furcia Pass

Please note that the chip costs 35,00 € and that if the chip is not returned that will be requested by invoice.

5. Withdrawals

Those unable to participate are not entitled to any reimbursement of their fee.

6. Maximum limit for assistance:

Refreshments and mechanical and medical assistance will be guaranteed until the end of the race.

7. Medical service:

The medical backup service comprises ambulances manned by doctors and nursing staff (telephone number 118)

8. Safety helmets:

COMPULSORY DURING ALL THE RACE

9. Definition of the event:

The 1st "Giro - Replica" is a non competitive uphill time trial and an event for touring cyclists. All participants must obey the rules of the road. The instructions of police officers and race controllers have to be followed.

11. Important:

The road between Furcia Pass and San Vigilio will be closed to traffic (including cyclists) until 1 p.m.; the road peak/ Plan de Corones -. Passo Furcia will be closed to traffic (including cyclists) until 3 p.m. The cyclist should therefore take due note. Carry spare clothing and a waterproof garment in case of bad weather - the finishing line is at a height of 2000 m. It is also compulsory to carry a kit for puncture repairs during the race.

12. Cancellation of the event

If the event has to be cancelled due to exceptional circumstances (weather conditions) there is no refund of the entry fee. In case the event has to be cancelled because the minimum number of participants is not to be reached, the registration fee will be refunded.

13. Alterations

The organizers reserve the right to make alterations to the programme. All official communications will be notified on the website www.sanvigilio.com

14. Signature

With the signature on the enrolment form, the participant accepts the above mentioned instructions and confirms that he is in possession of a private insurance, a third party insurance and the medical certificate according to D.M. 18.02.1992 and is in the condition to take part at the non competitive uphill time trial. Each participant carries the complete responsibility for his state of health on the race occasion. For accidents during the race the Organisation Committee will not take upon the liability.
